the right infrastructure for the right reasons: reduce the demand for car travel and energy; prioritise better and smarter transport choices; and ensure that new energy infrastructure minimises local impacts.

a beautiful countryside to sustain us all: promote the resilience of the food and farming system; enhance people's experience of the countryside; and champion and deliver solutions to eradicate littering in the countryside, including a national behaviour change campaign.
